Explanations about the Sri Lanka Tourism Safety Protocols

Sri Lanka Tourism has provided the following explanations/procedures for better understanding and to enable you to explain to your passengers the existing Sri Lanka Tourism Safety Protocols.

1. Airlines do not require CAA prior approval for the following categories of passengers who are entitled to arrive under the Sri Lanka Tourism Safety Protocol:
 - 1) Foreigners with Tourist Visa
 - 2) Sri Lankans who hold Dual Citizenship
 - 3) Sri Lankan Spouse or close family members (child, mother, father) who is carrying a Sri Lankan passport accompanying a Foreign National
 - 4) Foreign Passport Holders with a valid residence visa
2. For the above passengers the following guidelines are applicable:
 - a) No mandatory minimum stay.
 - b) Prior to departure it is mandatory for the passenger to have a hotel booking for up to 14 days of stay in a certified safe & secure level 1 Hotel.
 - c) It is mandatory to make payment to the hotel or travel agent for PCR tests (USD 40 per test) and Covid-19 Insurance of USD 12 for the passenger(s) when making hotel booking.
 - d) It is mandatory to obtain hotel booking reference number after b) and c) is completed.
 - e) Hotel or Travel Agent to send email to helloagain@srilanka.travel stating all details including passport number, number of pax., hotel reference, including payment for PCR tests and COVID Insurance, flight details, the category of passenger stated in 1 above, airport transfer details including vehicle number and chauffer details; and seek Sri Lanka Tourism assistance.
 - f) Sri Lanka Tourism to inform and coordinate with the Immigration & Emigration Department and assist passenger.
